- ☐ HME (Heat and Moisture Exchanger)
- ☐ Adhesives and skin barriers
- ☐ Stoma covers

#### **General Travel Items**

- ☐ Comfortable clothing adaptable to climate changes
- ☐ Personal hygiene items
- ☐ Sunglasses and sunscreen (for sunny destinations)
- ☐ Mobile phone and charger
- ☐ Travel adapter (for international travel)
- $\square$  Snacks and water bottle

- Keep important items in your carry-on luggage.
